Dear Clergy and Lay Members of the Alaska Conference of The United Methodist Church:

Today, I am writing to call for a Special Session of the Alaska Conference on January 29. 2024, responding to a unanimous request from the Leadership Team, the Mission District Task Force, and the AUMC Delegation to General Conference. The sole purpose of this session is to reconsider our decision to ask the General Conference to release us from Missionary Conference status in order to become a mission district of the PNW Conference.

The voting membership of the special session will consist of the clergy members of the annual conference as defined in ¶ 586 of The Book of Discipline and the lay members of the June 2023 Annual Conference (lay member or alternate, whoever was last seated in the June annual conference) in accordance with The Book of Discipline, ¶ 602.5.

The circumstances that existed both inside and outside the State of Alaska, as well as within and without The United Methodist Church, have changed dramatically since February 2020. This Special Session will allow us to revisit our decision with new information and to consider asking the delegation to work to defeat the petition we submitted to General Conference in early 2020. Your participation and discernment are crucial to this process.
